## BEGINNINGS

Ipswich was a place of numerous beginnings for Queensland. It was where Mary Keenan was the first-born of Maurice and Kathleen Keenan of Woodend Road. Maurice was a toolmaker in the Railway workshops of Ipswich. In the providence of God, at the end of the Second World War John Kalinowski (ancestry Polish) with his wife Caroline was appointed Station Master of the town. It so happened that their son Mervyn was returning from service in the Army and spent his spare time playing tennis at St Mary's Catholic Parish. It was love, set and match and Mary and Mervyn were married in St Mary's church in 1947.

The young couple set up their home at Sherwood. An essential element of their getting established was to become involved in the local parish. They welcomed five children into their family, Margaret, Maurice, Kevin, Gerard (that's me) and Annemarie. Our early schooling was at St Joseph's primary school. The girls then went to All Hallows, and the boys went to St Laurence's College. I fondly remember the priests and people of the area. They nurtured my belief and love of the Church. It was they who enabled me to hear and respond to God's call that had me entering Pius XII Seminary, Banyo in 1975.

On the 29<sup>th</sup> June 1981 I was ordained by Archbishop Francis Rush in St Stephen's Cathedral. It is inscribed into my bones the celebration of Church as the People of God. Appointments as Associate Pastor followed to Maroochydore and Beenleigh. Then I had the privilege of shepherding into life the parish of Capalaba. After nine years there I was asked by the Bishops of Queensland to receive training and serve as Spiritual Director of the Provincial Seminary. This was a very fulfilling ministry for fourteen years which saw the transition from Banyo, to an interim time at Wavell Heights, and the establishment of Holy Spirit Seminary back at Banyo. Then it was time to return to my first love in ministry as parish priest. At the beginning of August 2010 I became Parish Priest of Corinda Graceville Parish.

Now Archbishop Coleridge has asked me to come to Jubilee as your pastor. I particularly thank Fr Peter Brannelly who has been your energetic pastor of the parish for over eleven years. He, like his predecessors in the various communities, has been a good shepherd bringing the flock together and nurturing them in the hills and valleys of Jubilee. He has very capably led the parish as it became one. Fr Peter has ministered with great enthusiasm and vision and we are extremely grateful for his excellent pastoral leadership. As he starts afresh as Dean of the Cathedral we will keep him in our prayers.

The good ministry that Fr Peter has lived has only been possible because of the participation and support of the parishioners. In a short period of time Jubilee Parish has generated accolades across the Archdiocese because of the way it has brought diverse parishes into communion with a strong impetus for evangelization. It has been a place of faithfulness, creativity and acceptance of the challenges of proclaiming the Good News of God's Kingdom within our world.

I look forward to serving with you as we continue to be attentive to the presence of God in our lives, and trying to respond to that with generosity. It is exciting for me to become your pastor. Under God's generous guidance I look forward to the adventure that lies ahead of us. Help me to learn how to walk with you in the ways of God. Please pray for me that I will have a true shepherd's heart as we serve together in God's Kingdom that is Jubilee Parish.


