Congratulations to the 196 children who received their Confirmation last Thursday and Friday. This weekend our young people will have received their First Holy Communion. Jubilee Parish looks forward to their deep commitment to the Christian life into the future. Our thanks to class teachers, the parents, the leaders and co-ordinators, and all others who helped them be prepared for the sacraments.

St Gemma Galgini (1878-1903) called the Eucharist "the school of paradise where one learns how to love." She wrote an excellent reflection for all communicants: "Oh, what precious moments are those at Holy Communion! Communion is a happiness, that seems to me cannot be equalled even by the beatitude of the saints and angels... Jesus gives me all of Himself."

There is a popular prayer in which Catholics ask the Lord for the grace to receive Him in every Holy Communion with the same love with which they received him in their first Communion, with the same love with which they hope to receive Him at their last Communion, and with which they would want to receive Him if that were the only Communion of their life. The three parts of this beautiful prayer all came together on May 12, 1333 for an 11-year-old girl in Bologna, Italy, called Imelda Lambertini. Her body remains incorrupt seven centuries later and lies in a church in Bologna. In 1826, Pope Leo XII declared her blessed and proclaimed her the patroness of first communicants.

Our children have received the Sacraments of Initiation: Baptism and Confirmation. They are full-fledged members of the Body of Christ, and what was started in their Baptism when they were babies has been fulfilled by the full gifts of the Holy Spirit in Confirmation. Now the same Holy Spirit leads these children to receive the Body and Blood of the Eternal Son of God in Holy Communion.

Let us pray that the children making their first Holy Communion imitate the saints' love for Jesus in the Eucharist, and that the Eucharist becomes the source, summit, root and centre of their lives.

Anointing Mass at St Ambrose

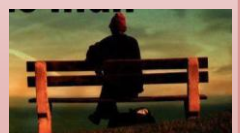
