## Sixteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time – 21 / 22 July 2018



Return and Rest? The Twelve return from their missionary foray, with reports of what they had done in Jesus' name. Jesus then invites them to 'Come away to a deserted place all by yourselves and rest a while.' It is an invitation into the wilderness, not a getaway holiday. The wilderness is where Israel was taught and cared for by their compassionate God. It is where Jesus withdrew to prepare for his own mission. It will be an opportunity for further formation for mission for the Twelve. It is time to be fed and nourished by *THE* Shepherd.

As they step ashore they are met by an enthusiastic crowd. Rather than being annoyed, Jesus meets them with compassion. The Shepherd again takes the initiative to teach them at length. 'Fresh and green are the pastures where he gives me repose. Near restful waters he leads me,

to revive my drooping spirit. He guides me along the right path; he is true to his name. If I should walk in the valley of darkness no evil would I fear. You are there with your crook and your staff; with these you give me comfort.' Psalm 22

**Bible Sunday is today!** Churches across Australia encourage people in their reading of the bible on this fourth Sunday of July. Every day is a good day to spend time with the scriptures. It is God's Word addressed to each and every one of us. Possibilities abound. You can take up a gospel and slowly read your way through, or you can focus on the steady pace that is provided by the Sunday readings. This is where your own Lectionary or *Break Open the Word* can be of such help. Take time and rest in the Word of God.

**St Mary Magdalene 22 July:** Yes Sunday 22 July is the feast of St Mary Magdalene, but she gets superseded by the Church's celebration of Sunday. St Mary Magdalene is the patron of our Bardon Church and so we do pray for her intercession. Companion to Jesus and present at his crucifixion and burial. In Matthew, Mark and John she is the first witness to the resurrection

**Fr Gerry on retreat:** From Wednesday 25 July to 1 August I will be away on my annual retreat. (There will be a day either side of that getting there and getting back.) Taking to heart this Sunday's gospel to 'Come away for a while'. Please keep me in your prayers as I will keep you in mine.

**Children Preparing for the Sacrament of Confirmation:** Parents attended the information night last Thursday. Over the next Sundays and weeks children and families will be preparing their children who have turned eight (Year 3) for the Sacrament of Confirmation on 30 – 31 August. The children have passports to be 'stamped' when they come along to mass. It is an opportunity to acknowledge how important they are within the community as they gather and are nurtured by our Good Shepherd. Please do pray for them and their families.

**First Communion:** From the year when the children turn nine (year Four), they are welcomed to the Lord's Table and receive Holy Communion for the first time. This is the climax of their Christian Initiation. The preparation for this, including participation at Sunday mass was explained at the parent night last Thursday. Children will be doing a similar thing in having their own passport towards the Sacrament and family preparation workbook. I was born in the Mater Hospital in South Brisbane, yet I grew up in Bundaberg. Being one of three, we always had a 'play date' when we were little, so I remember enjoying living in this town.


My memories of Bundaberg include watching the cane burn at night, and when the ash fell out of the sky, we would run around and try and catch it. The beach at Bargara was where everyone went to swim, yet there were mites in the water and sandflies, so that meant we were constantly scratching our legs and arms. Bundaberg is a very flat town, so there were very few hills. This meant that we

could ride around on bikes a lot. It was freedom and the outdoors! Do we give our kids the permission to do the same today?

I grew up in Holy Rosary Church. The exterior of the building is all white, so it stands out. I use to think of it as the ice cream church! I remember church was always heaps of fun, as it was a very charismatic congregation. Once, I remember the sign of peace took 5 minutes, as people got up and walked all around the church to shake everyone's hand. Imagine that!

As I start to plant myself into Jubilee Parish, I am beginning to hear stories from 'you' as parishioners about your connection to church. Unlike Maroochydore, where people have only settled in the last 10 years or so, many of you are 'second generation' in this parish. I find that remarkable.
